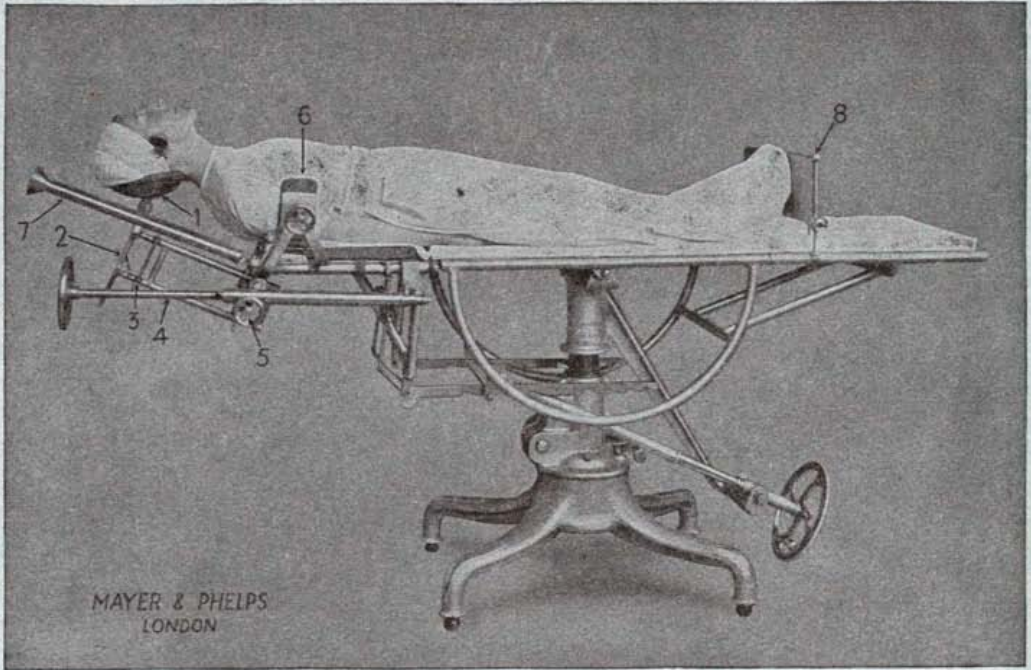




# Peroral Endoscopy Table
