Essays offered for publication should be in the hands of the Editor by January 1st of the year in which their publication is anticipated. All submissions will be read by a panel of referees, whose recommendations, the availability of space and an essay's agreement with the overall plan for a given issue determine whether a paper is accepted. Authors are encouraged to send their manuscripts as early as possible to The Editor, International Council for Traditional Music, Department of Music, Columbia University, New York, NY 10027.
