The actual meetings of the Second International Conference are over, but the Conference lives on in various forms:

- The activities of the Permanent Committee for the International Conferences of Human Genetics, which will be responsible for the selection of the place, the date and the program of the Third Conference.
- The Journal, Acta Geneticae Medicae et Gemellologiae, which devoted a series of supplements exclusively to the organization of the Second Conference and will continue to be at the service of the Permanent Committee.
- The Treatise « De Genetica Medica » whose first volume was published on the occasion of the Conference and whose special editorial flexibility will allow the incorporation of future scientific developments.
- The book of Abstracts (still obtainable from the Mendel Institute, Piazza Galeno 5, Rome, at a cost of \$ 12,50) besides carrying the abstracts of the papers provides an almost unique reference source for terms of genetics in four languages.
- The Proceedings (also obtainable from the Mendel Institute, at a cost of \$ 20,00) will appear in February, 1962, carrying the full text of all papers in the respective original languages.
- Final texts for publication in the Proceedings of the Conference must reach the Secretariate not later then Jan. 15, 1962.
