Membership is open to individuals and institutions for an annual subscription. Details available on the web site (<http://arlisanz.anu.edu.au/>).

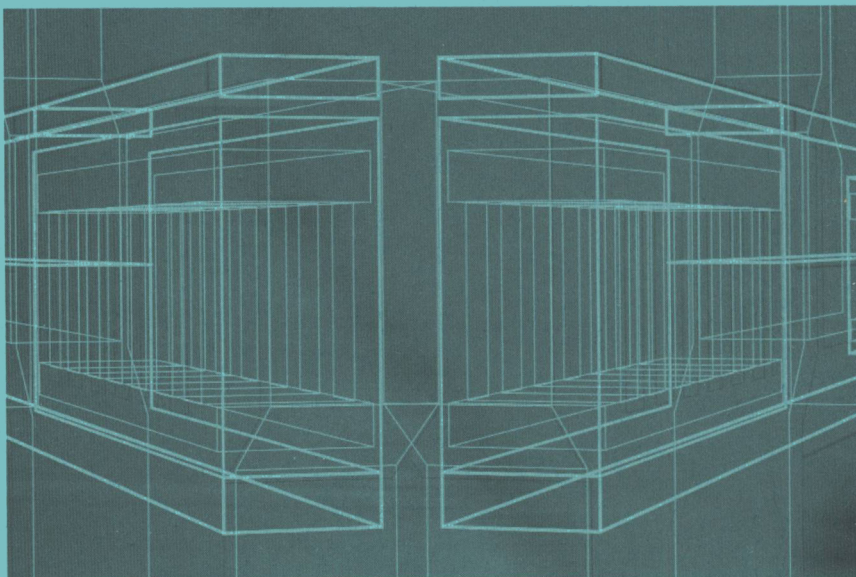
