This collection brings together some of the best recent research on the subject. Of the 30 essays, in English, French or German with English abstracts, some explore the attitude of working-class organisations and political parties towards racism and colonialism, others trace the cultural and ritual manifestations of 'proletarian internationalism'. There are contributions on the rise and development of organisations across national borders, and some instances are examined when working-class movements made a practical effort to achieve international solidarity.

With a few exceptions these essays were first presented as papers at a symposium held on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the International Institute of Social History in Amsterdam, 1985.

At present no similar comprehensive work exists in the field. This collection will be essential reading to all students of labour history.






