

The Division of Humanities at UCLA is accepting applications for the Andrew W. Mellon Postdoctoral Fellowships in the Humanities "Cultures in Transnational Perspective." We expect to appoint 4 or 5 fellows for a 1-year term renewable for a 2nd year beginning in fall 2010. Fellows must have earned their doctoral degree between January 2004 and June 2010. The Mellon Fellowship provides a stipend of \$53,000, fringe benefits, a moving allowance of \$1,500, and a research budget of \$2,000. All Fellows will be housed in home departments for which they teach 2 courses. Designed to explore the emerging field of Transnational Studies, the Mellon Program at UCLA aims to broaden the study of minority cultures from its national focus to global and comparative perspectives.
