*Doctoral Dissertations  
on Russia, the Soviet Union, and Eastern  
Europe Accepted by American,  
Canadian, and British Universities, 1973–1974*

For the first time since this annual section began appearing each December, the output of doctoral dissertations on Russia and the Soviet Union accepted by American and Canadian universities is slightly lower than the previous year. This statistic does not necessarily indicate a slackening of output, since the lists of some of the large graduate schools had not been received by the deadline. Because degrees are also granted by most universities past the usual spring commencement, with some awarded as late as December, complete coverage for the calendar year in current listings is not possible at this time. In addition, the practice of a few universities of refusing to compile doctoral lists, the very late appearance of *American Doctoral Dissertations* by as much as two years, and a publication deadline prevent this 1974 listing from being complete. The additional statistics of next year's list should reveal if a plateau has been reached. This current listing of two hundred forty-one titles is less than last year by thirty-five, with an additional one for 1971, and additional seventeen for 1972, and an additional one hundred thirty-five for 1973. Seventy-seven universities are represented (seventy in the United States and seven in Canada).

The listing for Eastern Europe contains one hundred thirteen dissertations from fifty-five American and two Canadian universities. The separate British list is lengthy again this year because of the compiler's visit to Great Britain in May, which enabled him to include a number of 1974 items, although unfortunately the major 1974 items for the University of London were not available. Fifteen British universities are represented with thirty-eight titles.

Thirty-two supplementary items, "auxiliary theses," have been appended to several sections.

For earlier lists of dissertations see the author's *Doctoral Research on Russia and the Soviet Union* (New York, 1960), for dissertations accepted through 1959, and the listings that have been published annually in the December issue of *Slavic Review* since 1964 (the 1964 listing also includes dissertations accepted in 1960–63). An announcement was made in an earlier number that volume 2 of *Doctoral Research on Russia and the Soviet Union* would be forthcoming shortly. Its publication has been held up, however, to provide a total cumulative list for fifteen years (1960–74). Volume 2 will include more than three times as many titles as volume 1, and will contain not only numerous classifications but also sub- and sub-subclassifications, with cross references, an index of Russian and Soviet names, and an index of authors.
