The European Consortium for Political Research is the major body concerned with the growth and development of political science in Europe. Grouping 110 institutions across 16 countries, it is also the leading European organization for social sciences as a whole.

Its major activities include:

- publication of the authoritative *European Journal of Political Research*, the *European Political Data Newsletter*, and the triennial *Directory of European Political Scientists*;
- the holding of Joint Sessions of Workshops, bringing together 300 to 400 participants in a different European center each year;
- research sessions of four to eight work groups;
- summer schools of international reputation in the field of quantitative research, attracting 150-200 participants to the universities of Essex and Grenoble annually;
- a Data Information Service centered at Bergen;

- plus a host of publications, seminars and exchange schemes designed to enhance the mobility of members of the profession, particularly graduate students, and to encourage joint research and publication.

The 1981 edition of *Political Science in Europe* is available from the Consortium. This publication contains information on all the member institutions, including courses offered, the research interests of departments and lists of staff members detailing their specialist areas. The aim of *Political Science in Europe* is to make those in the profession more aware of what is going on in other European departments, to enable them to make a preliminary choice of institutions at which they would like to work or study, and to discover departments with which they share common interests.
