Volume 1 of this manual deals with arithmetic or deterministic methods, while Volume 2 covers more advanced methods involving probabilistic and statistical methods.

The test for the inclusion of a method is that it has been found useful by a practitioner. The fact that a method may contain weaknesses from a theoretical point of view may be commented upon, but will not prevent its publication. Methods which have already been written up in journals are still eligible for inclusion in the manual, although the write-up should have a practical bias.
