## REVIEWS

These 12 papers were given at the sixth international symposium of the Groningen University Arctic Centre. Their linking theme is Arctic whaling; individual papers take a variety of approaches including environmental, historical, archaeological, biological and political. The first five introduce the environmental and biological background, dealing with biogeography, ecology, climate and sea ice cover. Two are concerned with early native whaling, three with recent European whaling, and one with present whaling policies, quotas and methods. The final paper summarizes a panel discussion on conflicts between commercial and aboriginal whaling.
