## REPRODUCTION OF PUBLISHED MATERIAL FROM CLAYS AND CLAY MINERALS

Authors wishing to reproduce copyrighted material, including illustrations, tables, and other information, from *Clays and Clay Minerals* and its predecessor single-issue volumes must adhere to the following procedure:

- "Volume 1," entitled *Clays and Clay Technology*. Authors must obtain written permission from the publisher, the California Division of Mines and Geology, 1416 Ninth Street, Sacramento, California 95814.
- "Volumes 2 to 5," Proceedings of National Clay Minerals Conferences. Authors must obtain written permission from the publisher, the National Academy of Science-National Research Council, Washington, D.C.
- "Volumes 6 to 15," Proceedings of National Clay Minerals Conferences. Authors must obtain written permission from the publisher, Pergamon Press, Oxford, U.K.
- Volumes 16 to 25. Authors must obtain written permission from one of the authors of the articles in question *and* written permission from the current editor of the Journal.
- Volumes 26 to present. Authors must obtain written permission from one of the authors of the article in question *and* must notify in writing the current editor of the Journal of their intent to reproduce the desired information.

In all cases, authors must specify exactly the material in question by article title, authors, volume number, and page(s). Each item must be identified separately. Blanket permission will generally not be given.

For material from volumes 16 to the present, an appropriate reference to the source of the reproduced material must be made, preferably by citing the original authors in the body of the text and listing the article in the Bibliography at the end of the article in the normal manner.
