WOSC Eighth International Congress of Cybernetics and Systems (June 11–15, 1990)

The Eighth WOSC Congress will be held at Hunter College, CUNY, New York (USA), in cooperation with the IEEE. This triennial conference is supported by international groups concerned with management, the sciences, computers, and technology systems.
