THE SEMON LECTURE, 1924.

On the afternoon of Thursday, 6th November, Dr Jean Guisez of Paris delivered, before a large audience assembled in the Hall of the Royal Society of Medicine, the Semon Lecture of the University of London. The Chair was occupied by Sir Wilmot Herringham, K.C.M.G., who, speaking in French, introduced the Lecturer.

As previously announced, Dr Guisez dealt with Malignant Disease of the Oesophagus, a subject with which his name has been very prominently associated for many years. A translation of the address, which was delivered in French, will be published in a future number of the *Journal*.

In the evening a reception was held at 64 Wimpole Street, by Sir St Clair Thomson, President of the Royal Society of Medicine, to which the members of the Sections of Laryngology and Otology had been invited to meet the Semon Lecturer.

INTERNATIONAL CLINIC OF OTO-RHINO-LARYNGOLOGY AND FACIO-MAXILLARY SURGERY.

This newly-formed International Clinic has recently published its programme of instruction for 1925. Recognising that a large number of specialists who visit Europe each year are handicapped by the necessity of travelling between different centres and by their want of familiarity with the various continental languages, the founders of the Clinic have organised two curricula in 1925, in which instruction will be given in English by teachers of recognised reputation.

Both courses will be given in Paris and will be taken part in by members of the staffs of the different hospitals in the City and by others who have been invited to lecture upon their particular specialties. The arrangements are under the direction of Dr Fernand Lemaitre of the Hôpital St Louis, 40 rue Bichat. The Course of instruction in Oto-Rhino-Laryngology will extend from the 15th January to the 15th May, and that in Facio-Maxillary Surgery from the 15th May to the 30th June. The Courses will include lectures, clinical and operative work, and laboratory attendance. The teaching staff, in addition to those resident in Paris, will include Sir St Clair Thomson, Dr Cornelius Coakley, Dr Chevalier Jackson, Dr Greenfield Sluder, Dr George E. Shambaugh, Mr H. D. Gillies, Mr Ferris Smith, and Mr J. Eastman Sheehan.

The Secretary-Treasurer, Mlle. Jeanne Gobreau, 120 Avenue Victor Hugo, Paris, XVI., will supply all the necessary information.


