## JOB PLACEMENT CENTER

The MRS And AIP Join Forces To Bring Complete Job-Placement Facilities To Boston

The Materials Research Society is inaugurating a Job Placement Center at the Annual Meeting in Boston this fall. The Center will be organized and staffed by the American Institute of Physics, of which the MRS is an Affiliate Society.

## Available to All Attendees

The services of the Job Placement Center will be available to any meeting attendee for a nominal fee of \$5. All of those on the Society's mailing list will receive instructions in a forthcoming mailing for participating in this new service. The submission of a Placement Service Candidate form will be part of this process. These forms will be available for review by participating employers, and interviews will be arranged during the meeting. Participants also are asked to bring copies of their resume to the meeting. A special room will be set aside at the conference hotel and the Center will

operate Tuesday through Thursday, Nov. 27-29, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Laboratories and universities wishing to participate in this placement effort will receive a special information packet describing the procedures. The service will be available to MRS Corporate Affiliates on a no-fee basis, and to others by arrangement with the Society's headquarters.

## Useful Aid in Placement

The new Job Placement Center represents the formalization of a process that has taken place on an ad-hoc basis at each of the Society's Annual Meetings. We hope that the Center will be used by MRS members, Corporate Affiliates, and others, and that it will serve as a useful aid in the placement and relocation of materials scientists, engineers, and technologists in appropriate positions.
