*William R. Childs* is associate professor of history at The Ohio State University. He is the author of *Trucking and the Public Interest* (1985), articles on regulation and infrastructure, and numerous book reviews. Currently, he is completing a history of the Texas Railroad Commission and state and national regulation up to the middle of the twentieth century. In 1995, he succeeded Edwin Perkins as editor of *Essays in Economic and Business History* and remained in that position for four years.

*Robert Gardella* is professor of history at the United States Merchant Marine Academy in Kings Point, New York. He is the author of *Harvesting Mountains: Fujian and the China Tea Trade, 1757–1937* (1994) and co-editor of *Chinese Business History: Interpretive Trends and Priorities for the Future* (1998). He is currently analyzing small business partnership contracts in late-nineteenth and mid-twentieth century China, and the implications of such instruments for the development of overseas Chinese business structures in Southeast Asia since the 1700s.

*Eugene Ridings* is professor emeritus of history at Winona State University. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Florida under the direction of Neill Macaulay in 1970. He is the author of *Business Interest Groups in Nineteenth-Century Brazil* (1994) and has published a number of articles on the interaction of business and government.

*Jonathan Soffer* is assistant professor of history at Polytechnic University in Brooklyn, New York. In 1992, he received his doctorate from Columbia University. He is the author of *General Matthew B. Ridgway: From Progressivism to Reaganism, 1895–1993* (1998). At present, he is writing a book on the society, politics, and culture of New York City during the administration of Mayor Ed Koch.
