Editorial Note

As from issue no. 50 (April-June, 1972) the subscription rates for *The China Quarterly* will be increased to £4 or U.S. \$10.00 a year post free. The price of individual copies will be £1 or U.S. \$2.50. The reduced rate for full-time students will remain unchanged at £2 or U.S. \$5.00 a year. This increase will be effective for all new subscriptions but those already paid for will remain valid until they expire. The payment of fees to contributors will also be discontinued as from issue no. 50. These measures have been made necessary by the continual rise in costs which the *Quarterly*, like almost every other magazine of this kind, faces.
