### Law and Economics of International Telecommunications

The traditional system of international telecommunications is undergoing fundamental changes caused by new technologies and new public policies on the national and international levels. The legal and economic issues underlying this process of privatization, deregulation and re-regulation are the subjet of studies undertaken at the Max Planck Institute in Hamburg, in cooperation with scholars from America, Asia and Europe. The series »Law and Economics of International Telecommunications« is dedicated to the publication of these studies. Comprising reports from representative countries that analyse the interface of national and international telecommunications systems, it deals with point-to-point communications, broadcasting and the »new media«. Further studies will deal with key policy issues including the protection of privacy and the role of international organizations, particularly the European Economic Communities, the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and the International Telecommunications Satellite Organization (INTELSAT).
